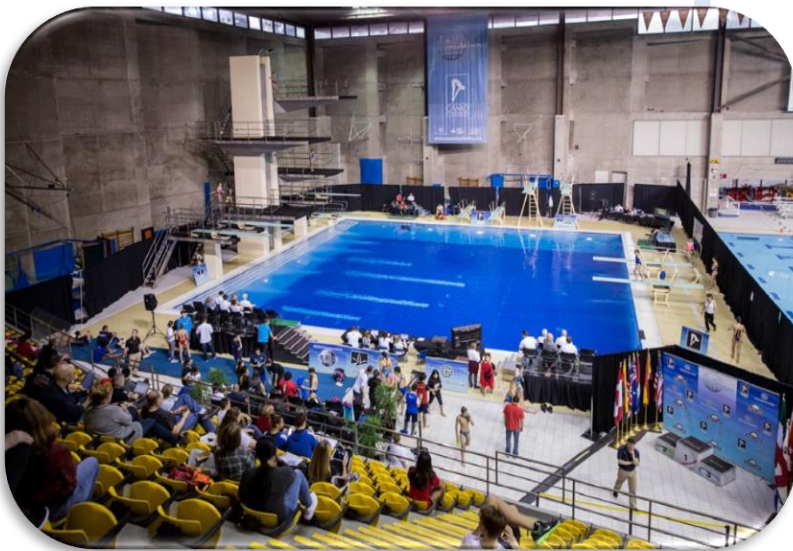

## > GENERAL INFORMATION

### 23rd edition of CAMO invitational International Championship.

Since 1996, dozens of countries meet in Montreal to take part in this high-level competition. Our championship is a great event to begin your competitive season.

## > EVENT

### **Boys and girls:**

- Group C (13 & under) – 1m, 3m and tower
- Group B (14-15) – 1m, 3m, and tower
- Group A (16 - 18) – 1m, 3m, and tower
- Open – 3m – tower and high diving (12 meters)

## > EQUIPMENT LIST

- (5) one-meter springboards
- (5) three-meter springboards
- Platforms: 3m, 5m, 7.5m, 10m and 12m
- Platforms all have a skid resistant black “rough-tex” surface
- A duller system is located under every 3m boards and all platforms

## > **RULES**

The 2017-2021 FINA shall be the official rules for this event. If there are any inconsistencies between this package and the Rule Book, the Rule Book shall prevail. Any decisions made at this championship by the Jury of Appeal shall be final. The Rule book is also available at [www.diving.ca](http://www.diving.ca)

Age- group determination is the diver's age as of December 31st, 2022.

Divers can compete in one age-group competition plus the Open events. However, they are not to compete in two different age groups.

Where one side of the pool is finished before the other, that side will be open for quiet warm-up. The Technical Director reserves the right to close a side for a warm-up if he deems it to be too noisy or disruptive to an event on the other side. Springboards will be open during platform warm up and vice versa.

Events may run up to 1-hour ahead of the scheduled and posted times. We highly suggested coaches and athletes should stay around the pool deck the day they are competing. A revised final schedule will be distributed upon the arrival of the teams.

## > **RULES FOR CANADIAN ATHLETES**

Age Group events: Only the top 12 of each event at the Junior National Championship are qualified for this meet. Those divers qualified can dive in all three junior events. If you would like an athlete to be considered for the meet who did not fulfill the criterion, you have the option to make a special request by e-mail to the technical chair, Stephane Lapointe at [slapointe@camoplungeon.com](mailto:slapointe@camoplungeon.com).

Senior events: The senior events have been approved to be qualifiers for Senior Nationals. All athletes who wish to participate in order to make the current season DPC Senior Point Standards can do so.

## > **JUDGING**

Refer to 2017-2021 Diving Plungeon Canada Rule Book. Dress code is in effect. All judges will be required to wear white shirts. If coaches can help out, please sign up on date of arrival in pool deck.

## > **ENTRY FEES AND ENTRY DEADLINE**

We ask that all athletes be registered for this competition using our platform called amilia with this link: <https://www.amilia.com/store/fr/camoplungeon/shop/programs/76941> .

You will need to:

- Create an account.
- Click on add a person under the actions section for every diver of your team.
- Go to the store with the link above.
- Add each and everyone of your divers to all their events.
- The registration fee will be added one time per diver.
- Go to check out an answer information and payment pages.

Clubs that are not able to do so must email Sofia Perrey [info@camoplungeon.com](mailto:info@camoplungeon.com) . Every coach is responsible of emailing the name of the club, name of their athletes and events they are participating.

Dive lists should be submitted using the ISS Dive Sheet Generator (Diver or Coach edition, version 16.1 or higher). Here is the link to download the application:

If you are unable to submit your lists over the internet, you will be able to fill in your dive sheets on-deck when you arrive. Dive sheets must be submitted 24h prior competition.
